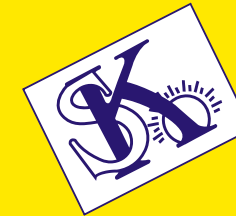

# STD. XI

## Coaching for Std. XI Students

Coaching for Std. XI has become an absolute must if a student wishes to do well in the MHT-CET exam. Std. XI, being college exams, most students feel that they have to simply enjoy college life and relax i.e. save their energy for the next year when they have to take up HSC Board exams and MHT-CET. So in Std. XI, they generally tend to take things easy and become complacent.

Adding to this complacency is the 105 Syndrome. These (105) are the minimum marks required in each subject to pass Std. XI and are seen as the only objective. This lack of motivation also affects the student's study in this most important academic year. Several otherwise good students fall prey to this Syndrome. As a result, they find the going tougher in Std. XII, for it is during Std. XI that the foundation is laid.

The basic tenets, on which the Std. XII syllabus depends, are imparted in the Std. XI course. A weak performance in Std. XI is magnified and reflected in Std. XII. In fact, over 40% of the syllabus for AIEEE and PMT is from the Std. XI syllabus. So, if you are not serious during Std. XI, then your chances of scoring at the AIEEE or PMT are fairly low.

### Eligibility

You are eligible for admission if you have passed your Std. X examination at the first attempt in 2010.

### Subjects

The subjects offered are Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology (theory only). Students can choose either the PM, PCM or PCMB course combination.

### Course Schedule

The course will commence within 10 days of the announcement of the SSC Board examination results, and practically end by January 2011. If some portion is left over, then a few lectures will be conducted on weekdays in February. If there is a need, revision lectures will be scheduled in February.

There will be two lectures, each of 90 minutes duration. Additional lectures will be held on Sundays and public holidays, as well.

### Batches

You can choose between the Morning and the Evening batch depending on your college timetable. In case you are not aware of your college timings at the time of admission with us,

we will subsequently allot you a suitable batch on intimation from you about your college timetable.

### Lecture Schedule

Group I : 6:45 am to 9:55 am

Group II : 8:25 am to 11:35 am

Group III : 6:15 pm to 9:20 pm

On Sundays and Public Holidays

For all three groups:

2:00 pm to 5:10 pm for two subjects (PM)

2:00 pm to 7:00 pm for three subjects (PCM)

2:00 pm to 8:40 pm for four subjects (PCMB)

All three Groups are available at the Vile Parle centre, while only Group I and Group III are available at the other centres.

We may alter the timings of Evening batch slightly. In case all the students at a centre in the Evening batch can come earlier than 6.15 pm, then the lecture timings will be pre-poned. This will be decided by the end of the first week of commencement of coaching.

### Tests

A total of 24 tests are conducted. These tests are chapter-wise as well as for a combination of chapters. Right from Std. XI, we start training students to tackle multiple choice type of questions.

Even the periodical tests are framed keeping this in mind. So the question papers are of two parts: Part I is subjective and Part II comprises objective multiple choice questions.

# STD. XII + MHT-CET (RANKERS' BATCH)

## An Ideal Batch for Scholars

It is approximately a two year coaching programme commencing from 22nd August, 2010. In this batch, teaching will be comprehensive, studying will be rigorous and no effort will be spared to get the best from each student in his quest to make it to the top.

**Eligibility:** A minimum 88% aggregate or a minimum 95% of total of marks for mathematics and science in Std. X.

**Batches:** Only one batch at each centre. (Whether this batch is in the morning or afternoon, enquire at the centre.)

**Timings:** Morning : 6:45 am to 1:30 pm  
Afternoon : 2:00 pm to 8:40 pm

**Lecture Programme:** Initially, topics which are common to both, Std. XI and Std. XII, will be taught. While simultaneous coaching will be imparted for HSC syllabus and MHT-CET for Physics and Chemistry; the MHT-CET coaching in Biology and Mathematics will be done only after completion of their HSC syllabus. This will help students to have a well-balanced, evenly-spread and steady curriculum which will not put too much pressure on them.

At this stage, the syllabus is completed. In case any portion is remaining, more lectures will be arranged.

### Revision and Doubt Solving

As per the following table, each day there will be a lecture of revision and doubt solving for 2 hrs and test for 3 hrs. Most of these tests will be on MHT-CET.

The months of December 2011 and January 2012 will solely be devoted for revision and prelims for the Std. XII board exams. After the HSC board exams, the focus will be completely on MHT-CET exams, till they are held.

**Lecture Frequency:** Till 120th day of coaching for PCMB, there will be 4 lectures everyday. For PCM, there will be 3 lectures everyday. Each lecture will be of 90 minutes duration.

**Periodical Tests and Prelims:** A salient feature of 2 years coaching programme for Rankers' Batch is more number of tests. As the course commences early, it is possible to conduct a large number of tests over a well-spread time period.

**For the HSC:** A total of 40 tests for PCMB and 30 tests for PCM. These tests will include regular chapterwise tests and terminal exams.

**For the MHT-CET:** More than 100 tests will be conducted. In addition to these tests, 2 prelims for HSC and 20 for MHT-CET will also be held. Any student who wishes to write extra tests will be welcome to do so.

# STD. XII + MHT-CET (VACATION BATCH)

## The most Popular Programme

In this course, the teaching staff, study material and number of lectures are the same as Rankers' Batch.

Although we would prefer students with high marks in Std. X, we will also consider students whose performance in Std. X may not have been a true reflection of their calibre. No deserving student will be deprived of our coaching.

If you do not qualify for admission in the Rankers' Batch, you can seek admission to Vacation Batch, which is available on a first-come-first-alloc basis. The earlier you approach us for registration, the better choice you will have for selecting your Group (i.e. Morning / Evening and PCM / PCMB).

## Lecture Programme

Coaching for the HSC+ MHT-CET courses will be conducted simultaneously and regular tests will be held immediately after each chapter / topic / subject.

Initially, along with HSC, MHT-CET objectives training will be imparted only in Physics and Chemistry. During the 2011 Diwali vacation, coaching for MHT-CET in Biology and Mathematics will be given. First we finish the entire MHT-CET syllabus in Physics & Chemistry, and only then start Mathematics and Biology. This will help students to have a well-balanced, evenly-spread and steady curriculum which will therefore not put too much pressure on them.

The course will commence on 25th December, 2010 and go on till 30th November, 2011. By then the entire syllabus of Std. XII and MHT-CET will be over. The months of December 2011 and January 2012 will solely be devoted for revision and prelims for the Std. XII Board exams. After the HSC Board exams, the focus will be completely on MHT-CET exams, till they are held.

## Lecture Frequency

### Phase I, II and IV:

Sundays, Public Holidays and during College Vacations.

For PCMB, there will be 4 lectures every day. For PCM, there will be 3 lectures every day. Each lecture will be of 90 minutes duration.

### Phase III:

Weekdays: 2 lectures per day, either in the morning (6:45 am to 9:55 am) or in the evening (6:00 pm to 9:10 pm). 4 Lectures per day on Sundays and public holidays.

Batches will be decided as per college theory and practical timetables, and are based on the data forms issued to students

for ascertaining their respective college timings. The timetable for this phase is made only a week after colleges open i.e. by 15th June.

### Phase V:

Each day 2 Lectures (Revision and doubt solving)

Note: The timings for coaching in any of the above mentioned groups is either 6:45 am to 1:30 pm OR 2:00 pm to 8:40 pm. At most of the centers, we have both the timings for all four groups; while, at some centers, we may have only morning or only afternoon batches. Hence, we take preference from students about timings. You will find a column regarding this in the admission form. Whether the group timings at a particular centre is morning or afternoon, will be communicated to the students at least 1 week prior to the commencement of course. While we would not like to cause inconvenience to students / parents, in case it is imperative, then parents and students must cooperate.

## Periodical Tests and Prelims

Tests form a major feature of our integrated coaching programme.

**For the HSC:** A total of 32 tests for PCMB and 24 tests for PCM. These tests will include regular chapter-wise tests which will be held every Sunday.

**For the MHT-CET:** More than 80 tests will be conducted.

Besides these tests, terminal exams and prelims (2 for HSC and 10 for MHT-CET) will also be held. Any student who wishes to write extra tests will be welcome to do so. The detailed timetable booklet will be given to students before Christmas vacation so that there is no confusion at any later stage. This will help them properly plan their studies.

## Assessment of Test Papers

Qualified college professors who are well-versed with the marking pattern in the HSC Board Exams will assess the test papers. This will enable you to assess your progress and help to plan your preparation accordingly.

Assessed papers will be returned to the students within a week of the test. In addition, students will have the facility to get their papers reassessed personally by our teachers.

Tests for MHT-CET are assessed using 'Scantron' computerised hardware and software, as employed by the

Directorate of Medical Education and Research (DMER) authorities. This results in quick, accurate marking and assessment.

## Fees

Fees can be paid in 4 equal installments. First, at the time of admission. Second, in December 2010. Third, in January 2011. Final installment in February 2011.

# GENERAL INFORMATION

## Refund of Fees

There is absolutely no refund of fees under any circumstances (including change of plans, change of residence, transfers, change of college, change of stream, etc.) except under the Disclaimer Clause.

## Disclaimer Clause for all Courses

Normally, in any institute the fee once paid is neither refundable nor adjustable under any circumstances. So, when a student joins a course, inspite of the fact that he may not be satisfied with the services provided, he has to continue there because fees will not be refunded. We are supremely confident of the quality of our teaching and services rendered to the students. However in order to be fair to the student community, we have a 'Disclaimer Clause' whereby a student has the option of disclaiming his admission within a week of the start of the course. No questions will be asked. Full fees, minus the total Service Tax, will be refunded on receipt of a written request signed by the student's parent/guardian. To take advantage of Disclaimer Clause, a student should have attended all the lectures on at least the first day of the course or first day after joining the course according to the timetable of his/her batch or course.

Students who have joined for Std. XI, Std. XII and MHT-CET, can disclaim admission only in Std XI itself, after which their admission to Std. XII + MHT-CET would stand cancelled. The Disclaimer Clause is applicable only once and at the very first instance of joining the Institute. The Disclaimer Clause is NOT applicable if we receive the 'request' later than seven days of the start of the course.

## For Students Who Fail in Std XI

The course for Std. XII at our institute commences while the students are still in Std. XI. By the time the Std. XI college results are declared, over 50% of the Std. XII syllabus is completed. A student detained in Std. XI can opt out of further coaching by presenting a certified copy of his Std. XI Mark-sheet within 7 days of the declaration of results, whereby only 50% of the fees paid for Std. XII and MHT-CET would be refunded by cheque, less the total Service Tax.

However, in the case of a student from Rankers' Batch, no refund is possible.

## General Information

- **Student Responsiveness:** Commensurate with our sincere efforts to provide the best guidance, we expect you too, to be equally responsive by working hard throughout the course period. Therefore, this course is not for those who wish to just get enrolled and wait for the miracle to happen.

The course at our classes is very demanding and requires commitment and determination to meet the challenge. You must weigh all pros and cons before you enroll with us. And unless you are willing to be determined, dedicated and disciplined, you need not seek admission with us; you might be depriving the benefits of our classes to many other deserving students who are eager to join.

- **Lecture Timings:** The Dates, Timings and Duration mentioned in this Prospectus are tentative.

- **Study Material:** Authentic, comprehensive yet concise, the study material comes in the form of professionally printed books/booklets.

- **Tests:** Regular tests are scheduled right throughout the course. Performance is monitored, both for individual assessment and comparative rankings.

- **Attendance:** Attendance is a must for all lectures and tests. Parents are requested to ensure their child's regularity and punctuality for the lectures and tests.

- **Discipline:** Disorderly conduct or non-compliance with rules and regulations of the institute will disqualify students from further attendance, solely at the cost and risk of the student's own future.

- **Parent-student Counselling:** Efforts are made to involve both parents and their wards, on a one-to-one basis, in cases where there seems to be a lack of commitment. Regular updates on each student's attendance and test performance are offered through normal telephone lines, Email or SMS.

We ensure that every parent is well aware of marks scored by child in every test conducted by us.

- **Service Tax:** Service tax is payable at the rate applicable at the time of paying the fee/installment.

- **Rebate on Fees:** Fees are fixed and no arbitrary discounts are offered to anyone, irrespective of personal relationships or financial conditions.

However, a performance incentive is offered to all those who have secured a minimum of 97% of total of marks

for mathematics and science in Std. X or a minimum of 90% aggregate.

Rebate in fees will also be given to the sibling of our past students.

## Admission Procedure

Admissions open immediately after announcement of Std. X results.

All admissions on first-come-first-allot basis.

- **Documents:** At the time of admission, a student must come personally accompanied by one of his parents, and submit the following documents:

1. Application Form, duly filled and complete in all respects.

2. Certified photocopy of Std. X Mark-sheet.

3. Two, recent, stamp-size, unattested colour photographs.

Certified photocopy of the Mark-sheet will be returned immediately after verification. The photographs will be retained by the institute.

- **Fees:** The fees can be paid in cash or by a local Cheque / Pay Order / Demand Draft in favour of Kalrashukla Classes Private Limited and must accompany the Admission Form. Fees can also be paid by any MASTER / VISA Credit / Debit Card.

Preferred mode of payment for fees is by Cheque / Pay Order. In case a parent wishes to pay in Cash, then the fees must be paid before 3:00 pm on bank working days. After 3:00 pm, fees in Cash will NOT be accepted.

Please note that the fees for Std. XI, Std. XII + MHT-CET (Med./Engg./Med+ Engg.), unless paid by Cash, must be paid by separate Cheques / Pay Orders / Demand Drafts / Credit Card Charge Slips along with separate, relevant Admission Forms. Separate receipts will be issued for the same. Outstation cheques will not be accepted.

A single Cheque / Pay Order / Demand Draft / Credit Card Charge Slip for two courses will NOT be accepted.

Students must retain all receipts very carefully and present them whenever requested by the management.

Those students who fail to pay subsequent installments by the due dates will have their admission declared null and void, and the monies paid earlier will be forfeited. The Management does not take the responsibility of reminding

the students about ensuring payment of subsequent installments.

- **Fees in Installments:** Please submit a post-dated cheque for each installment separately. The post-dated cheques (PDC) must have dates according to the following instructions:

In case, date of admission is 5th July 2010 then,

For Rankers' Batch:

The date of second installment will be 5th Oct. 2010.

The date of third installment will be 5th Dec. 2010.

The date of final installment will be 5th Feb. 2011.

For Vacation Batch:

The date of second installment will be 5th Dec. 2010.

The date of third installment will be 5th Jan. 2011.

The date of final installment will be 5th Feb. 2011.

## Please Note

- It is compulsory to submit PDCs at the time of admission, in case of payment by installments.
- The admission form will not be accepted without PDCs.
- Parents will be given an acknowledgment slip with the details of PDCs submitted.
- Parents may pay for a few or all of the installments by cash / credit card, provided that the payment is done a day prior to the due date of installment.
- In the case of dishonored cheque, parents will have to pay applicable bank charges for every default.
